10 11	WHEREAS, public institutions of higher education in the Commonwealth are meant to promote the
12	prosperity and flourishing of the Commonwealth and its citizens; and
13	WHEREAS, in furtherance of their purpose, public institutions of higher education should pursue
14	admissions and enrollment policies that prioritize the enrollment of Virginia students; and
15	WHEREAS, public institutions of higher education in the Commonwealth that face declining
16	revenues may address revenue shortfall by pursuing admissions and enrollment policies that prioritize
17	the admission and enrollment of non-Virginia students and, in turn, cause undue competition in
18	admissions for Virginia students; and
19 20	WHEREAS, it is imperative to compare admissions and enrollment rates at the public institutions of
20 21	higher education in the Commonwealth with those in each other state in order to inform the General Assembly of the potential need for intervention; now, therefore, be it

24	admissions and enrollment at public institutions of higher education in the Commonwealth and in each
25	other state.
26	In conducting its study, the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia (SCHEV) shall collect
27	and analyze recent and accurate data from within and outside the Commonwealth and compare rates of
28	in-state and out-of-state undergraduate student admissions and enrollment at public institutions of higher
29	education in the Commonwealth with those in each other state.
30	Technical assistance shall be provided to SCHEV by each public institution of higher education in
31	the Commonwealth. All agencies of the Commonwealth shall provide assistance to SCHEV for this
32 33	study, upon request. The State Council of Higher Education for Virginia shall complete its meetings by November 30,
33 34	2017, and shall submit to the Governor and the General Assembly an executive summary and a report
35	of its findings and recommendations for publication as a House or Senate document. The executive
36	summary and report shall be submitted as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative
37	Automated Systems for the processing of legislative documents and reports no later than the first day of
38	the 2018 Regular Session of the General Assembly and shall be posted on the General Assembly's
39	website.
