HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 835

3 Commending Fredericksburg Academy. 4

Patrons-Cole, Dudenhefer, Howell and Orrock; Senator: Reeves

6 WHEREAS, Fredericksburg Academy, located in Spotsylvania County, celebrated 25 years of 7 independent educational excellence during the 2016 - 2017 school year; and

WHEREAS, Fredericksburg Academy was established to provide local families the opportunity to 8 9 send their children to an independent school, an option that did not exist in the Fredericksburg region at 10 the time; and

WHEREAS, Fredericksburg Academy was founded as a coeducational, nonsectarian school and 11 opened on September 8, 1992, with 60 students aged pre-kindergarten through eighth grade; and 12

13 WHEREAS, after Fredericksburg Academy's enrollment doubled, the academy moved to its current location in Spotsylvania County in 1993; that same year, the academy opened its Upper School division 14 with ninth grade, and added one grade level in each subsequent year; and 15

WHEREAS, the Class of 1997 became Fredericksburg Academy's first graduating class; and

17 WHEREAS, Fredericksburg Academy dedicated the John and Virginia Hazel Sports Center in 1998; 18 and

19 WHEREAS, on November 3, 2000, the Constance Suzanne O'Connell Memorial Library and 20 Computer Center was dedicated in memory of Fredericksburg Academy student Connie O'Connell; and WHEREAS, Fredericksburg Academy established a permanent home for its Upper School and 21

22 dedicated the Hazel Family Arts and Sciences building in 2004; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of the significant role of the Quarles family and The Gladys T. Quarles 23 24 Charitable Trust in the founding of Fredericksburg Academy, the Board of Trustees dedicated the 25 Middle School facility as the Gladys T. Quarles Building on December 19, 2007; and 26

WHEREAS, the Class of 2016 became Fredericksburg Academy's 20th graduating class; and

27 WHEREAS, in its 25-year history, 100 percent of Fredericksburg Academy graduates have been 28 admitted to four-year colleges and universities; and 29

WHEREAS, Fredericksburg Academy remains the region's only truly independent school; and

30 WHEREAS, Karen Moschetto, the fourth head of school of Fredericksburg Academy, who has served 31 since 2010, and the Board of Trustees, Fredericksburg Academy's governing body, will ably guide the academy into the next 25 years of fulfilling its mission to inspire and empower students to discover, to 32 33 engage, and to imagine the limitless nature of themselves and the world; now, therefore, be it

34 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the General Assembly hereby 35 commend Fredericksburg Academy on the occasion of its 25th anniversary; and, be it

36 RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates prepare a copy of this resolution 37 for presentation to Karen Moschetto, head of school of Fredericksburg Academy, as an expression of the 38 General Assembly's admiration for the school's contributions to Spotsylvania County.
