16100175D **HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 90** 1 2 House Amendments in [] - February 16, 2016 3 Applying to the Congress of the United States to call an amendment convention pursuant to Article V of 4 the United States Constitution for the purpose of proposing an amendment to the United States 5 Constitution that pertains to the subject of balancing the federal budget. 6 Patron Prior to Engrossment-Delegate LeMunyon 7 8 Referred to Committee on Rules 9 10 WHEREAS, this nation has become deeply in debt as its expenditures have exceeded available revenues so that the total federal public debt now exceeds \$ [47 19] trillion and continues to increase, 11 and is of such great proportion that responsibility for its payment, with interest, will be passed to future, 12 unborn generations of Americans to assume without their consent; and 13 14 WHEREAS, attempts to curtail federal spending, confine expenditures to available revenues, and 15 reduce the annual deficit have not been successful; and WHEREAS, in recent years Congress has mandated the implementation of government programs by 16 the states without providing funding for all such programs and could continue to encroach on state 17 budgets as a means of balancing the federal budget; and 18 19 WHEREAS, the Constitution of Virginia provides for a balanced budget, and this provision has 20 reinforced the inherent fiscal common sense of spending only funds available and has contributed to the 21 Commonwealth's outstanding reputation for sound fiscal management and policy; and 22 WHEREAS, efforts in Congress to amend the United States Constitution to add a balanced budget 23 requirement have not been successful; and 24 WHEREAS, Article V of the United States Constitution grants to the states the right to initiate a 25 process of amending the Constitution through application by the legislatures of two-thirds of the several states to the Congress, calling for an amendment convention; and 26 27 WHEREAS, the Congress is required by Article V to call such a convention upon receipt of such 28 applications from two-thirds of the states; now, therefore, be it 29 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That the Commonwealth of Virginia 30 hereby apply to the Congress of the United States to call an amendment convention pursuant to Article 31 V of the United States Constitution for the purpose of proposing an amendment to the United States Constitution that pertains to the subject of balancing the federal budget; and, be it 32 33 RESOLVED FURTHER, That this application is to be considered as covering the balanced budget 34 amendment provisions of the presently outstanding Article V balanced budget applications from other 35 states, including previously adopted applications from Alabama, Alaska, Arkansas, Colorado, Delaware, 36 Florida, Georgia, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Maryland, Michigan, Mississippi, Missouri, 37 Nebraska, Nevada, New Hampshire, New Mexico, North Carolina, North Dakota, Pennsylvania, Ohio, 38 South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, and Utah, and shall be aggregated with those other applications for the 39 purpose of attaining the two-thirds of states necessary to require the calling of a convention; and, be it 40 RESOLVED FURTHER. That the other states be encouraged to make similar applications for an 41 amendment convention pursuant to Article V of the United States Constitution; and, be it RESOLVED FURTHER, That this application shall constitute a continuing application for such 42 amendment convention pursuant to Article V of the United States Constitution until the legislatures of 43 two-thirds of the states shall have made such applications and such convention shall have been called by 44 45 the Congress of the United States; and, be it RESOLVED FINALLY, That the Clerk of the House of Delegates transmit copies of this resolution 46 to the President of the United States, the Speaker and the Clerk of the United States House of 47 Representatives, the President and the Clerk of the United States Senate, the members of the Virginia 48 49 Congressional Delegation, and the legislatures of each of the several states, attesting the adoption of this resolution by the Virginia General Assembly. [That the provisions of this resolution shall expire on July 50 51 1, 2026.]
