10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	<b>1.</b> § 1. That the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services shall, in cooperation with
12	the Department of Medical Assistance Services, study the potential use of the Involuntary Mental
13 14	Commitment Fund to fund mental health treatment in the Commonwealth. In conducting such study, the Department shall evaluate (i) the potential use of the Involuntary Mental Commitment Fund to fund both
14	involuntary temporary detention and voluntary treatment in a health care facility for the treatment of
16	mental illness to reduce the use of involuntary treatment in the Commonwealth, (ii) the potential benefits
17	of transferring management of the Involuntary Mental Commitment Fund from the Department of
18	Medical Assistance Services to the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services, and
19	(iii) any other strategies for improving use of the funds in the Involuntary Mental Commitment Fund to
20	improve access to mental health services in the Commonwealth. The Department shall report its findings
21	to the Joint Subcommittee Studying Mental Health Services in the Commonwealth in the 21st Century by
