Every person, except the owner or lessee of the premises, his family and nonrioting guests, and 13 14 public officers and persons assisting them, who remains at the place of any riot or unlawful assembly 15 after having been lawfully warned to disperse, shall be is guilty of a Class 3 1 misdemeanor.
