14	to pull down, injure, or destroy, any dwelling house or other building, or assist therein, or perpetrate any
15	premeditated injury on the person of another, he shall be is guilty of a Class 6 5 felony.
16 17	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is \$0
18	for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and cannot be determined for
19	periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile Justice.
