10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11 12	1. That § 28.2-606 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: § 28.2-606. Notice of application.
12	A. Notice of the application shall be (i) posted by the Commission for not less than sixty 30 days at
13	the courthouse on its website. The Commission shall provide by registered or certified mail written
15	notice of its receipt of the application to (i) [the manager or administrator of the county or city in
16	which the ground applied for lies,] and in at least two or more prominent places in the vicinity of the
17	ground and [(ii)] published the mailing address of the holder of a current lease for any syster planting
18	ground that is contiguous to the ground applied for, and [(iii) (ii)] the last known address, as shown
19	on the current real estate tax assessment book or records, of the owner of any riparian property located
20	within 200 feet of the ground applied for. The provision of notice to a common interest community as
21	defined in § 55-528 shall be deemed adequate to notify all associated unit owners or lot owners.
22	B. The Commission shall publish notice of the application at least once a week for four two
23	consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in that county or city the area in which the
24	ground applied for lies.
25	C. Notice provided pursuant to this section shall invite and provide information about the submission
26	of written comments on the application. The cost of the notice required by this section shall be borne by
27	the applicant.
