9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 22.1-176 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 22.1-176. Transportation of pupils authorized; when fee may be charged; contributions;
12	regulations of Board of Education.
13	A. School boards may provide for the transportation of pupils, but nothing herein contained shall be
14	construed as requiring such transportation except as provided in § 22.1-221.
15	B. When a school board provides transportation to pupils for extracurricular activities, other than
16 17	those covered by an activity fund, which that are sponsored by the pupils' school apart from the regular instructional program and which that the pupils are not required to attend or participate in the school
17	instructional program and which <i>that</i> the pupils are not required to attend or participate in, the school board may accept contributions for such transportation or charge each pupil utilizing such transportation
19	a reasonable fee not to exceed his pro rata share of the cost of providing such transportation. A school
20	board may waive such fees <i>fee</i> for any pupil whose parent or guardian is financially unable to pay them

22	C. When a school board provides transportation to pupils who do not live in the school division, the
$\overline{23}$	school board may charge each pupil utilizing such transportation a reasonable fee not to exceed his pro-
24	rata share of the cost of providing such transportation. A school board shall waive such fee for any
25	pupil whose parent is financially unable to pay it, including any pupil who is eligible for free or
26	reduced lunch.
27	D. When a school board provides transportation to pupils for field trips which that are a part of the
28	program of the pupils' school or are sponsored by such school, the school board may accept
29	contributions for such transportation.
30	D. E. The Board of Education shall promulgate such regulations as shall be in the public interest to
