10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 22.1-176 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 22.1-176. Transportation of pupils authorized; when fee may be charged; contributions;
13	regulations of Board of Education.
14	A. School boards may provide for the transportation of pupils, but nothing herein contained shall be
15	construed as requiring such transportation except as provided in § 22.1-221.
16	B. When a school board provides transportation to pupils for extracurricular activities, other than
17	those covered by an activity fund, which that are sponsored by the pupils' school apart from the regular
18	instructional program and which that the pupils are not required to attend or participate in, the school
19	board may accept contributions for such transportation or charge each pupil utilizing such transportation
20	a reasonable fee not to exceed his pro rata share of the cost of providing such transportation. A school
21	board may waive such fees fee for any pupil whose parent or guardian is financially unable to pay them
22	it.
23	C. When a school board provides transportation to pupils who [do not live in the school division
24	attends school outside the school division], the school board may charge each pupil utilizing such
25	transportation a reasonable fee not to exceed his pro rata share of the cost of providing such
26	transportation. A school board shall waive such fee for any pupil [who receives special education
27	services pursuant to the federal Individuals with Disabilities Act (20 U.S.C. § 1400 et seq.) or] whose
28	parent is financially unable to pay it, including any pupil who is eligible for free or reduced lunch.
29	D. When a school board provides transportation to pupils for field trips which that are a part of the
30 21	program of the pupils' school or are sponsored by such school, the school board may accept

contributions for such transportation. $\frac{D}{E}$. The Board of Education shall promulgate such regulations as shall be in the public interest to effect the intent of this section. SB1517E
