| 10 | 1. § 1. The Department of Health Professions shall establish a work group of interested stakeholders to |
| 11 | examine the risks and benefits of having community health workers in the Commonwealth, including |
| 12 | standardized training for such workers. The work group shall (i) develop a scope of practice and core |
| 13 | competencies for community health workers; (ii) adopt consensus training and certification standards; |
| 14 | and (iii) identify (a) a certifying entity, (b) legislative and health system policy priorities to support the |
| 15 | sustainability of community health workers, (c) strategies to educate the public and private third-party |
| 16 | payers and health care systems to increase awareness of the uses and the role of a community health |
| 17 | worker, and (d) sustainable payment systems for community health worker systems as a part of an |
| 18 | integrated health care team. The Department of Health shall submit a report on the work group's |

findings and recommendations to the Governor and to the Chairmen of the House Appropriations and Senate Finance Committees by October 15, 2017.
