8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 54.1-2963.3 as follows:
10	§ 54.1-2963.3. Treatment of Lyme disease.
11	No health care provider who provides treatment for Lyme disease or other tick-borne disease in
12	accordance with a clinical practice guideline maintained by the National Guideline Clearinghouse after
13	obtaining informed consent, which shall include an explanation of the risks and benefits of such
14	treatment, from the patient to whom treatment is provided shall be the subject of any disciplinary
15	proceeding by the Board of Medicine for following such clinical practice guideline, absent gross
16	negligence or willful misconduct.
