8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 29 of Title 54.1 an article
10	numbered 10, consisting of a section numbered 54.1-2997, as follows:
11	Article 10.
12	Direct Primary Care Agreements.
13	§ 54.1-2997. Direct primary care agreements.
14	A. A direct agreement between a patient, the patient's legal representative, or the patient's employer
15	and a health care provider for ongoing primary care services in exchange for the payment of a monthly
16	periodic fee is not health insurance or a health maintenance organization, provided that the health care
17	provider does not require patients to pay monthly periodic fees prior to initiation of the direct
18	agreement coverage period. A health care provider who participates in a direct primary care practice
19	may participate in a health insurance carrier network so long as the provider is willing and able to
20	meet the terms and conditions of network membership set by the health insurance carrier.

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
