10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 64.2-528 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 64.2-528. Order in which debts and demands of decedents to be paid.
13	When the assets of the decedent in his personal representative's possession are not sufficient to
14	satisfy all debts and demands against him, they shall be applied to the payment of such debts and
15	demands in the following order:
16	1. Costs and expenses of administration;
17	2. The allowances provided in Article 2 (§ 64.2-309 et seq.) of Chapter 3;
18	3. Funeral expenses not to exceed \$4,000;
19	4. Debts and taxes with preference under federal law;
20	5. Medical and hospital expenses of the last illness of the decedent, including compensation of
21	persons attending him not to exceed \$2,150 for each hospital and nursing home and \$425 for each
22	person furnishing services or goods;
23	6. Debts and taxes due the Commonwealth;
24	7. Debts due as trustee for persons under disabilities; as receiver or commissioner under decree of
25	court of the Commonwealth; as personal representative, guardian, conservator, or committee when the
26	qualification was in the Commonwealth; and for moneys collected by anyone to the credit of another
27	and not paid over, regardless of whether or not a bond has been executed for the faithful performance of
28	the duties of the party so collecting such funds;
29	8. Debts for [unpaid] child support [obligations arrearages] ;
30	9. Debts and taxes due localities and municipal corporations of the Commonwealth; and
31	9 10. All other claims.

32 No preference shall be given in the payment of any claim over any other claim of the same class, 33 and a claim due and payable shall not be entitled to a preference over a claim not due. ENGROSSED
