17102876D **SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 298** 1 2 Offered January 11, 2017 3 Designating September 12, in 2017 and in each succeeding year, as the Saragarhi Day of Sikh Pride in 4 Virginia. 5 Patron-Reeves 6 7 Referred to Committee on Rules 8 9 WHEREAS, on September 12, 1897, the 21 soldiers of the 36th Sikh Regiment of the British Indian Army defending the Saragarhi communication post in the North Western Frontier Province of what is 10 now Pakistan, were attacked by a force of between 10,000 and 14,000 Pashtun tribesmen; and 11 WHEREAS, outnumbered 500 to 1, but recognizing the importance of the outpost's mission to act as 12 13 a heliographic signal relay between Fort Lockhart and Fort Gulistan, the Saragarhi defenders, under 14 detachment commander Havildar Ishar Singh, unanimously decided to hold their position; and WHEREAS, cut off from reinforcements by the approaching enemy, the Saragarhi defenders relied 15 on their knowledge of the terrain and superior training and equipment to hold the outpost, which 16 consisted of a small block building with ramparts and a signal tower; and 17 WHEREAS, between 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m., the Saragarhi defenders repulsed several charges by 18 19 the enemy forces, including coordinated assaults from different angles, but sustained heavy casualties 20 and ran perilously low on ammunition; and WHEREAS, after another attempt to provide relief to the Saragarhi defenders failed, the tribesmen 21 advanced under the cover of smoke from burning shrubs and grass, and the remaining defenders were 22 23 forced to retreat behind the inner walls of the outpost; and 24 WHEREAS, Havildar Ishar Singh, who had been gravely wounded earlier in the battle, and two of 25 his men charged the tribesmen to allow the other Saragarhi defenders to set up a new defensive position; 26 their sacrifice inspired the remaining defenders, who engaged the enemy in hand-to-hand combat inside 27 the fort; and 28 WHEREAS, at 3:30 p.m., the last Saragarhi defender, Sepoy Gurmukh Singh, requested permission 29 from Fort Lockhart to abandon his post in the signal tower and join the battle; his request was granted; 30 and 31 WHEREAS, the Saragarhi defenders held their post to the last man, and their inspirational bravery 32 and dedication to duty in the face of overwhelming odds is celebrated by Sikhs and fellow soldiers 33 throughout the world; and 34 WHEREAS, the Saragarhi defenders-Havildar Ishar Singh, Naik Lal Singh, Naik Chanda Singh, 35 Lance Naik Sundar Singh, Lance Naik Ram Singh, Lance Naik Uttar Singh, Lance Naik Sahib Singh, 36 Sepoy Hira Singh, Sepoy Daya Singh, Sepoy Jivan Singh, Sepoy Bhola Singh, Sepoy Narayan Singh, Sepoy Gurmukh Singh, Sepoy Jivan Singh, Sepoy Gurmukh Singh, Sepoy Ram Singh, Sepoy Bhagwan 37 Singh, Sepoy Bhagwan Singh, Sepoy Buta Singh, Sepoy Jivan Singh, Sepoy Nand Singh—earned an 38 39 indelible place in history by their valor, loyalty, and courageous sacrifice; now, therefore, be it 40 RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly designate 41 September 12, in 2017 and in each succeeding year, as the Saragarhi Day of Sikh Pride in Virginia; and, 42 be it RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the Senate transmit a copy of this resolution to Puneet 43 44 Ahluwalia so that members of the Sikh community may be apprised of the sense of the General 45 Assembly of Virginia in this matter; and, be it RESOLVED FINALLY, That the Clerk of the Senate post the designation of this day on the General 46 Assembly's website. 47
