3. Committee: House Committee on Militia, Police and Public Safety

4. Title: Renewal of concealed handgun permits; notice.

5. Summary: Provides that the concealed handgun permit application form allow for the applicant's email, or other electronic address, be captured so that the notice of permit expiration can be electronically sent to the applicant.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary (see Item #8)

8. Fiscal Implications: The proposed legislation would allow, if the circuit court clerk has an electronic system for issuance of concealed handgun permits, and such system has the capability of sending electronic notices to permit holders, and if a permit holder requests such notice on the concealed handgun application form, to notify the permit holder by electronic mail at least 90 days prior to the permit expiration date that the permit will expire.

According to the Compensation Board, the proposed bill is not expected to have a material fiscal impact on the clerks of the circuit courts.
