4. Title: Online renewal of special identification cards for persons 70 years of age or older.

5. Summary: This bill provides that applicants 70 years of age or older may renew special identification cards online. Current law requires such renewal in person.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill, as written, will impact the Department of Motor Vehicles' (DMV) automated systems and its web site. It is estimated that this will require 220 information technology staff hours at a cost of \$13,970. However, it is anticipated that the staff hours required can be accomplished during the normal work schedules for DMV employees, given current workloads.
