4. Title: Regulations governing hospitals; facilities performing abortions.

5. Summary: Regulations governing hospitals; facilities performing abortions. Removes language classifying facilities that perform five or more first trimester abortions per month as hospitals for the purpose of complying with regulations establishing minimum standards for hospitals.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Minimal; see item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill would not have a fiscal impact on the Commonwealth. The bill removes the hospital classification for facilities that perform five or more first trimester abortions per month, which would result in the loss of \$1,050 in fee revenue. The reduction of the 14 identified facilities that would be surveyed is not significant enough for a reduction in staff.
