Summary: The proposed legislation states the intent of the General Assembly to support a strong Commonwealth and to fulfill the principles of the federal Morrill Land-Grant Acts of 1862 and 1890 and the Smith-Lever Act of 1914. In addition, Virginia's two land-grant universities, Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University and Virginia State University, shall maintain strong programs of instruction, research, and the extension of knowledge in agriculture, natural resources, family and consumer sciences, community viability, youth development, and other such fields as are necessary to fulfill their respective land-grant missions. These two institutions shall ensure that these objectives will be addressed in all strategic plans for the future.
