2. Patron: Orrock

3. Committee: Passed both houses.

4. Title: Virginia Department of Transportation to maintain a certain segment of Spotsylvania Parkway.

5. Summary: Requires the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), as of July 1, 2020, to take over normal right of way maintenance of an approximately two-mile segment of Spotsylvania Parkway that is currently maintained pursuant to a 2005 "Easement and Cost Sharing Agreement" unless the homeowners association (HOA) that is party to such cost-sharing agreement and Spotsylvania County reach a new road maintenance agreement prior to July 1, 2020.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation will result in some additional expenditures to VDOT for maintaining the right of way of this segment of highway if no cost-sharing agreement is reached between the HOA and Spotsylvania County. However, it is impossible to estimate the expenditures at this time.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Virginia Department of Transportation, Spotsylvania County

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: According to VDOT, if control of this maintenance is turned over to the state it would set a precedent for other entities that maintain landscaping along highways.
