Summary: Requires the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), as of July 1, 2020, to take over normal right of way maintenance of an approximately two-mile segment of Spotsylvania Parkway that is currently maintained pursuant to a 2005 "Easement and Cost Sharing Agreement" unless the homeowners association (HOA) that is party to such cost-sharing agreement and Spotsylvania County reach a new road maintenance agreement prior to July 1, 2020.

Fiscal Implications: This legislation will result in some additional expenditures to VDOT for maintaining the right of way of this segment of highway if no cost-sharing agreement is reached between the HOA and Spotsylvainia County. However, it is impossible to estimate the expenditures at this time.
