4. Title: Neighborhood Assistance Act tax credits; Board of Education.

5. Summary: Requires any neighborhood organization submitting a proposal to the Superintendent of Public Instruction for an allocation of tax credits for the program year beginning July 1, 2017 to include with its proposal a list of all localities in the Commonwealth in which the neighborhood organization provided services during the program year beginning July 1, 2016. Requires the Department of Education to aggregate and report on this information no later than December 1, 2017.
