3. Committee: House Committee on Militia, Police and Public Safety

4. Title: Concealed handgun permit; permit requirements.

5. Summary: Provides that a concealed handgun permit shall be of a size comparable to a Virginia driver's license and may be laminated or use a similar process to protect the permit. Current law requires that the permit be no larger than two inches wide by three and one-fourth inches long.
