4. Title: Require mental health first aid training for resident assistants

5. Summary: This bill requires each resident assistant in a student housing facility at a public institution of higher education to participate in mental health first aid or equivalent training prior to the commencement of his duties.

8. Fiscal Implications: Public institutions of higher education should be able to absorb the cost of the required training using their auxiliary enterprise revenues.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Virginia's public institutions of higher education

Other Comments: Language could be considered directing the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia to work collaboratively with the Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Services and the public institutions of higher education to establish guidelines for the mental health first aid training.
