2. Patron: Peace

3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Department of General Services; review of proposed acquisitions of real property; exceptions.

5. Summary: Provides an exception to the requirement that before any agency of the state acquires real property, it must follow the guidelines adopted by the Department of General Services. The bill grants this exception in cases of the acquisition of real property to be held in trust for the benefit of a state-recognized Indian tribe, provided that such property is (i) annexed into the existing reservation of such tribe and (ii) located within a one-mile radius of the boundary of such reservation. The bill provides however, that these acquisitions of real estate shall be subject to the review of the Office of the Attorney General and the approval by the Governor.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: No state fiscal impact.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill is not expected to have a state fiscal impact.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: The Department of General Services and state-recognized Indian tribes.
