4. Title: Condemnation powers and proceedings; notice to owner or tenant.

5. Summary: Requires an authorized condemnor, or the Commissioner of Highways, as applicable, to give notice to the owner or tenant of freehold property subject to condemnation no later than 15 days prior to the filing or recordation of a certificate in any "quick take" condemnation proceeding. Current law requires notice but does not provide a time frame within which such notice must be given.
