4. Title: Registration with Department of Criminal Justice Services by tow truck drivers; exceptions.

5. Summary: This bill clarifies the definition of tow truck driver to exclude individuals who are (i) not for hire in the Commonwealth, (ii) transporting a vehicle from a location outside of the Commonwealth to a destination within the Commonwealth, or (iii) transiting the Commonwealth while transporting a vehicle from and to a location outside of the Commonwealth. This bill will exempt these individuals from registration as tow truck drivers with the Department of Criminal Justice Services as a result of this bill.
