4. Title: Virginia Industries for the Blind; exempted from certain procurements

5. Summary: The proposed legislation exempts from the requirements of the Public Procurement Act (§ 2.2-4300 et seq.) the Virginia Industries for the Blind when procuring components, materials, supplies, or services for use in commodities and services furnished to the federal government in connection with its operation as an AbilityOne Program-qualified nonprofit agency for the blind.

8. Fiscal Implications: It is expected that the passage of this bill would facilitate increased sales to the federal government under the AbilityOne Program and thereby generate additional revenue for the Virginia Industries for the Blind (VIB). While this additional revenue would need a nongeneral fund appropriation to be expended, there is no concrete estimate or expectation that the current VIB appropriation is insufficient. Therefore, it is assumed that should any increase in appropriation become necessary, such need can be addressed administratively until such time the Appropriation Act can be adjusted.
