4. Title: Department of Transportation; Office of Intermodal Planning and Investment of the Secretary of Transportation; responsibilities.

5. Summary: This bill shifts responsibilities for transportation planning activities from the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) to the Office of Intermodal Planning and Investment of the Secretary of Transportation. The bill specifies VDOT's core functions and limits the agency's duties to those core functions. The bill requires transparency in the development of the Six-Year Improvement Program and State of Good Repair Program by the Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB) and requires the CTB and VDOT to make public certain information related to the selection of projects.

8. Fiscal Implications: This proposal delineates the responsibilities of the Department of Rail and Public Transportation (DRPT), VDOT and the Office of Intermodal Planning and Investment as it relates to transportation planning activities. No fiscal implications are anticipated from these changes.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Secretary of Transportation; Office of Intermodal Planning and Investment; CTB; VDOT; DRPT.
