4. Title: Confidentiality of Department of Juvenile Justice records; gang task forces.

5. Summary: Permits the Department of Juvenile Justice to share, at its discretion, the social reports and records of children who are committed to the Department to gang task forces, provided that (i) the task force consists of only representatives of state or local government or (ii) includes a law enforcement officer who is present at the time of the disclosure of the information.
