Current law requires that a representative of the Virginia Crime Prevention Association be appointed by the Governor to the Criminal Justice Services Board. The proposed legislation would eliminate this requirement and substitute, instead, a representative of the Virginia Association of Campus Law Enforcement Administrators.
