**4. Title:** Report of law-enforcement officer involved in accident.

**5. Summary:** This bill provides that any law-enforcement officer who is listed as a driver in a motor vehicle accident report submitted to the Department of Motor Vehicles will not have the accident listed on his driving record if he was driving a motor vehicle provided by a law-enforcement agency in the course of his employment and was engaged in law-enforcement activity at the time of such accident.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary. See Item #8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) previously had had an administrative policy that allowed an officer involved in a crash to submit a letter from his commanding officer stating that the crash occurred while on official duty. This legislation would set this policy in *Code*.

It is not anticipated that the engrossed bill will have a fiscal impact.
