**4. Title:** Students receiving home instruction; participation in AP and PSAT/NMSQT.

**5. Summary:** Requires school boards to make Advanced Placement (AP), Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT), and the PreACT examinations available to students receiving home instruction. School boards must adopt written policies that specify the date by which such students shall register to participate in such examinations and must notify such students and their parents of such registration deadline and the availability of financial assistance to low-income and needy students to take such examinations.
