4. Title: Registration of tow truck drivers

5. Summary:

To operate a tow truck, a person must be registered with the Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS). The proposed legislation would authorize the agency to provide a temporary registration or driver authorization document that would be effective upon the submission of an application for registration and would expire upon the issuance or denial of a permanent registration.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate.

8. Fiscal Implications:

To implement the proposed legislation, the agency would need to re-program its automated registration system. The potential cost of such re-programming is not known and would be paid from the nongeneral fund revenue derived from the application and renewal fees paid by tow truck drivers to support the program.
