4. Title: Concealed handgun permit; change of address.

5. Summary: Under the proposed the legislation, a permit holder can present written notice of the change of address on a form provided by the Department of State Police for a court to issue a replacement concealed handgun permit due as a result of the change of address.

8. Fiscal Implications: Current law requires the permit holder to present proof of address to the issuing Circuit Court but it does not specify how the proof must be provided. The bill requires the Department of State Police (the Department) to provide a change of address form for permit holders to use when requesting a replacement concealed gun permit due to a change of address. The bill is expected to have a minimal fiscal impact to the Department or on the court system.
