5. Summary: Provides that non-confidential court records can be made available to any third party, including online access to subscribers, for the purpose of confirming a person's complete date of birth.

8. Fiscal Implications: The proposed bill would allow electronic access to non-confidential criminal court records to any third party to confirm a person's complete date of birth.

The enrolled budget bill includes \$137,000 from the general fund in FY 2018 to cover the costs of hiring contractors to develop the portal necessary to provide the online access to subscribers as outlined in the bill.
