8. Fiscal Implications: This bill would have a nongeneral fund impact on the Commonwealth. The agency would require one position in order to meet the provisions of the bill. Fees for licensing applications will be set at a level sufficient to cover the costs of the additional position. Currently the Board of Medicine does not have sufficient staff to manage this new program as the board is working at capacity. Based on the expected increase in licensing activities, an administrative licensing assistant is needed to review the increase in new

doctors of medical science applications. The cost for the additional position would be \$64,875 (\$34,720 salary plus benefits) annually.
