**4. Title:** Switchblade knife

### 5. Summary:

Current law prohibits the concealed carrying of numerous weapons, including switchblade knives, without a permit. Violation of the provision is a Class 1 misdemeanor. A second or subsequent violation is a felony.

The proposed legislation would exempt switchblade knives from the prohibition if they are carried for the purpose of engaging in a lawful profession or in a lawful recreational activity that is aided by the use of a switchblade knife.

#### 8. Fiscal Implications:

The proposed legislation would provide an exemption to an existing criminal statute. Therefore, it could result in fewer persons being held in jails or prisons. In addition, because criminal offenses can result in fines that are deposited into the Literary Fund, the proposed legislation could result in less revenue for the Literary Fund. However, there is not sufficient data available to project any potential resultant cost savings or revenue reduction.
