3. Committee: Courts of Justice

4. Title: Concealed handgun permits; reciprocity with other states.

5. Summary: The proposal requires the General Assembly to determine whether states meet the statutory qualifications for Virginia to recognize the concealed handgun permit of a person from another state. Under current law, this function is performed by the Superintendent of State Police in consultation with the Office of the Attorney General; the proposal removes this function from these agencies.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the comments received from the General Assembly staff on the bill, the proposal has no operational fiscal impact on the House of Delegates; the fiscal impact on the Senate is indeterminate.
