3. Committee: Education and Health

4. Title: School service providers; student access to collected personal information.

5. Summary: Requires school service providers to provide each student or his parent with access to a downloadable electronic copy of any student personal information pertaining to such student that has been collected, maintained, used, or shared by the school service provider. The bill requires such electronic copy to be in a machine-readable format.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: There is no anticipated state fiscal impact as a result of the provisions of this bill, nor is there a direct fiscal impact to local school divisions; however, school service providers likely would pass any incurred costs on to local school divisions. Additionally, the pool of available service providers could decrease if some providers are unwilling or unable to meet the requirements of the bill. A smaller supply of service providers could increase costs to school divisions. Any actual fiscal impact to local school divisions is indeterminate.
