4. Title: School service providers; student access to collected personal information.

5. Summary: Requires school service providers to provide, either directly to the student or his parent or through the school, access to an electronic copy of such student's personal information in a manner consistent with the functionality of the school service. Permits local school boards to specify in contracts between the local school board and the school service provider that such electronic copy be in a machine-readable format.
