**4. Title:** School service providers; student access to collected personal information.

**5. Summary:** Requires school service providers to provide a student's parent, either directly or through the student's school or teacher, access to a copy of such student's personal information that has been collected, maintained, used, or shared by the school service provider. Permits local school boards to specify in contracts between the local school board and the school service provider that such copy be in a machine-readable format.
