- **4. Title:** Public schools; student discipline.
- 5. Summary: Prohibits students in preschool through grade three from receiving long-term suspension or being expelled from attendance at school except under certain circumstances.
- 6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No
- 7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8.
- 8. Fiscal Implications: Under current regulations, a student suspended or expelled for more than 15 days who does not receive alternate education from the public school division, such as home-based education, is removed from Average Daily Membership (ADM). This bill could reduce the volume of long-term suspensions and expulsions, resulting in an indeterminate increase in ADM. Any additional cost to the state cannot be determined at this time but is likely minimal.

- 11. Other Comments: This bill is similar to the House substitute of HB 1536.
