6	A BILL to authorize the Department of Transportation to review implications of enrollment in a federal
7	pilot program or project.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. § 1. That the Department of Transportation (the Department) shall convene a work group to identify
10	the implications of the Commonwealth's participation in a federal data collection pilot program or
11	project involving six-axle tractor truck semitrailer combinations weighing up to 91,000 pounds and
12	utilizing interstate highways. The Department may consult relevant stakeholders and may review (i) the
13	fee structure for qualifying tractor trucks, (ii) the axle spacing for qualifying tractor trucks, (iii) issues
14	related to reasonable access from loading facilities onto a primary or secondary highway and interstate
15	highways, (iv) the sufficiency of existing data in determining if certain routes and bridges should be
16	excluded from the federal pilot program or project, and (v) any other issues as deemed relevant or
17	appropriate by the Department. The Department shall complete its meetings by November 30, 2018, and
18	shall submit to the General Assembly and the Governor an executive summary and a report of its
19	findings and recommendations. The executive summary and report shall be submitted as provided in the
20	procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for the processing of legislative documents
21	and reports no later than the first day of the 2019 Regular Session of the General Assembly and shall
22	be posted on the General Assembly's website.
