9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:	
10	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 23.1-609.1 as follows:	
11	1 § 23.1-609.1. Veterans; tuition and mandatory fee waivers.	
<b>12</b>	A. As used in this section, "veteran" has the same meaning as provided in § 23.1-500.	
13	B. A veteran is entitled to a waiver of undergraduate tuition and mandatory fees for up to 150 credit	
14	hours at any public institution of higher education if:	
15	1. He resided in the Commonwealth for at least six months immediately preceding his entrance into	
16	service in the Armed Forces of the United States;	
17	2. He served on active duty in the Armed Forces of the United States for at least one year;	
18	3. He returned to reside in the Commonwealth within six months of his discharge from service in the	
19	Armed Forces of the United States; and	
<b>20</b>	4. He resides in the Commonwealth.
