4	A BILL to amend and reenact § 30-371 of the Code of Virginia, relating to membership of the
5	Commission on Employee Retirement Security and Pension Reform.

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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 30-371 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 30-371. (Expires July 1, 2021) Commission on Employee Retirement Security and Pension
13	Reform; purpose; membership; terms; quorum; expenses.
14	A. The Commission on Employee Retirement Security and Pension Reform (the Commission) is
15	established in the legislative branch of state government. The purposes of the Commission shall be to
16	study, report, and make recommendations relating to the financial soundness of retirement plans
17	covering state and local government employees including the Virginia Retirement System (§ 51.1-124.1
18	et seq.), retirement benefits pursuant to § 51.1-138, the hybrid retirement program under § 51.1-169, the
19	State Police Officers' Retirement System (§ 51.1-200 et seq.), the Virginia Law Officers' Retirement
20	System (§ 51.1-211 et seq.), and the Judicial Retirement System (§ 51.1-300 et seq.); the suitability of
21	retirement plans offered or maintained for current state and local government employees and the
22	attributes of retirement plans that will be suitable for future employees; the impact on state and local
23	governments of the anticipated retirement of experienced employees between 2016 and 2026 and
24 25	strategies for replacing such employees; and the elements of compensation and benefits packages that
25 26	are essential to attracting and retaining a highly productive state and local government workforce. In carrying out its duties, the Commission shall study the unfunded liabilities of state and local defined
20 27	benefit retirement plans and strategies for reducing such liabilities, additional options for employee
28	retirement, investment choices and products offered by the Virginia Retirement System, incentives for
<b>2</b> 9	state and local government employees to make voluntary contributions to their employer-sponsored
30	retirement plans, contributions by the Commonwealth and local governments to retirement plans for
31	employees, and additional options for employee compensation and benefits.
32	The Commission shall make such recommendations as it deems appropriate with respect to the
33	foregoing matters.
34	B. The Commission shall consist of 21 members that include 11 legislative members, eight
35	nonlegislative citizen members, and two ex officio members, as follows: the Speaker of the House of
36	Delegates, the Chairman of the House Committee on Appropriations, the Chairman of the House
37	Committee on Finance, and three four members of the House of Delegates to be appointed by the
38	Speaker of the House of Delegates; the Majority Leader of the Senate, any Chairman of the Senate
39	Committee on Finance who is not the Majority Leader of the Senate, and three members of the Senate
40	to be appointed by the Senate Committee on Rules; five nonlegislative citizen members to be appointed
41	by the Speaker of the House of Delegates, one of whom shall be appointed from a list of five nominees
42	jointly submitted by the Virginia Association of Counties and the Virginia Municipal League, one of
43	whom shall be appointed from a list of three nominees submitted by the Virginia Governmental
44 45	Employees Association, and one of whom shall be appointed from a list of three nominees submitted by the Virginia Education. Association: three nonlogicalities gitizen members to be appointed by the Senate
45 46	the Virginia Education Association; three nonlegislative citizen members to be appointed by the Senate
46 47	Committee on Rules, one of whom shall be appointed from a list of five nominees jointly submitted by the Virginia Sheriffs' Association and the Virginia State Police Association; and the Directors of the
<b>4</b> 7 <b>48</b>	Department of Human Resource Management and the Virginia Retirement System, who shall serve ex
<b>4</b> 9	officio with nonvoting privileges. All other Commission members shall have voting privileges.
50	Nonlegislative citizen members shall be citizens of the Commonwealth.

onlegislative citizen members shall be citizens of the Commonwealth. C. Legislative members and other state government officials shall serve terms coincident with their 51 52 terms of office. Nonlegislative citizen members shall serve a five-year term. Vacancies shall be filled in 53 the same manner as the original appointments.

54 D. The Commission shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman for a three-year term, who shall be 55 members of the General Assembly. Upon the expiration of such three-year term, the Commission shall elect a new chairman and vice-chairman for a two-year term. The chairman and vice-chairman may not 56 succeed themselves to the same position. The Commission shall hold meetings quarterly or upon the call 57 58 of the chairman. A majority of the voting members of the Commission shall constitute a quorum.

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- E. Members of the Commission shall be compensated for their service and reimbursed for all reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties as provided in the general 60 61 appropriation act.
