9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. § 1. That no local governing body shall establish provisions related to procurement of goods,
11	professional services, or construction that would require a wage floor or any other employee benefit or
12	compensation above what is otherwise required by state or federal law to be provided by a contractor
13 14	to one or more of the contractor's employees as part of a contract with the locality. For purposes of this act, "professional services" means [any type of personal service to the public that requires as a
15	condition precedent to the rendering of such service the obtaining of a license or other legal
16	authorization and shall include, but shall not be limited to, the personal services rendered by medical
17	doctors, dentists, architects, professional engineers, certified public accountants, attorneys-at-law, and
18	veterinarians the same as that term is defined in § 2.2-4301].
19	§ 2. The provisions of this act shall not (i) affect contracts between a locality and another party that
20	were executed prior to January 1, 2019, or the renewal or future rebids of services thereof or (ii)
21	prohibit a locality from entering into contracts for economic development incentives in which the
22	company receiving the incentives is required to maintain a certain stated wage level for its employees.
