11	1. That § 46.2-869 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

13	Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this article, upon the trial of any person charged with
14	reckless driving where the degree of culpability is slight, the court in its discretion may find the accused

16	not guilty of reckless driving but any person who drives a vehicle on any highway (i) in a negligent
