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| 10 | Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: |
| 11 | 1. That § 22.1-212.2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: |
| 12 | § 22.1-212.2. Virtual Virginia. |
| 13 | A. From such funds as are appropriated, the Department of Education shall establish a statewide |
| 14 | electronic classroom to be known as the Virtual Virginia Program. Virtual Virginia shall be made |
| 15 | available to every public high school in Virginia the Commonwealth. Enrollment in Virtual Virginia |
| 16 | during the school year is open, on a space-available basis and free of charge, to each public high |
| 17 | school student in the Commonwealth and each high school student in the Commonwealth who receives |
| 18 | home instruction. |
| 19 | The Department may utilize the services of the Commonwealth's educational television stations and |
| 20 | other providers, as well as any other appropriate technology for the purposes of implementing Virtual |
| 21 | Virginia. |
| 22 | The services of this program shall be limited to educational purposes. Educational purposes shall |
| 23 | include, but not be limited to, instruction in subject areas that are not available in all schools and |
| 24 25 | in-service training for instructional, administrative and support personnel. |
| | B. The Department may contract with one or more local school boards that have created online |
| 26 27 | courses to make one or more such courses available to other school divisions through the Virtual |
| 27 28 | Virginia Program. The Department shall approve all courses offered through Virtual Virginia, including those made available by local school boards to other school divisions. A school board that makes one or |
| 20 29 | more of its online courses available to other school divisions through Virtual Virginia (i) shall not be |
| 3 0 | considered a multidivision online provider pursuant to § 22.1-212.23 and (ii) may charge a per-course or |
| 31 | per-student fee to school divisions to defray the costs of developing the course and providing course |
| 32 | instruction using teachers employed by the offering school board. The Department shall approve any |
| 33 | such fee schedule before a school board offers any such online courses through Virtual Virginia. |
| 34 | C. The Department shall establish the Virtual Learning Advisory Committee, which shall consist of |
| 35 | one superintendent or his designee from each of the eight superintendent's regions, the Superintendent of |
| 36 | Public Instruction or his designee, and such other members as the Department deems appropriate, not to |
| 37 | exceed three additional members. The contractor that manages Virtual Virginia shall serve as a |
| 38 | nonvoting ex officio member. The Committee shall advise the Department on (i) online courses, |
| 39 | in-service training, and digital instructional resources that school divisions need to meet the |
| 40 | Commonwealth's graduation requirements and (ii) strategic planning to expand blended and online |
| 41 | learning opportunities in Virginia's public schools, including cost-effective access to high-need and |
| 42 | low-demand courses training content and digital resources |
