11 12	1. That § 23.1-907 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
	§ 23.1-907. Articulation, dual admissions, and guaranteed admissions agreements; admission of
13	certain comprehensive community college graduates; dual enrollment.
14	A. The board of visitors of each baccalaureate public institution of higher education shall develop,
15	consistent with Council guidelines and the institution's six-year plan as set forth in § 23.1-306,
16	articulation, dual admissions, and guaranteed admissions agreements with each associate-degree-granting
17	public institution of higher education.
18	B. The Council and each public institution of higher education shall develop a passport credit
19 20	program, including any necessary guidelines for such program. In developing the program, the Council
20	and each public institution of higher education shall establish competencies and standards for each
21	passport credit course. Any course that does not meet or exceed the standards developed under the
22	program shall not be deemed a passport credit course. Such passport credit program shall require that it
23	is the responsibility of the course provider to ensure that a passport credit course meets the standards of the program. Each passport credit course shell estify a lawar division general education requirement of
24	the program. Each passport credit course shall satisfy a lower division general education requirement at
25 26	any public institution of higher education.
26 27	C. The Council and each public institution of higher education shall develop a one-year uniform
	certificate of general studies program as set forth in subdivision 20 of § 23.1-203. All credits earned in
28	academic subject coursework by students attending an associate-degree-granting public institution of
29 30	higher education who complete the one-year uniform certificate of general studies program are transferrable to a baccalaureate public institution of higher education in accordance with Council
30 31	
31 32	guidelines. D. C. The Council shall prepare an annual report on the pertinent aspects of the pipeline of students
32 33	transferring from comprehensive community colleges to baccalaureate public institutions of higher
33 34	education.
35	E. D. The Council, consistent with its responsibility to facilitate the development of articulation, dual
36	admissions, and guaranteed admissions agreements set forth in §§ 23.1-203 and 23.1-908, shall develop
37	guidelines for such agreements.
38	F. E. Each comprehensive community college shall develop agreements for postsecondary degree
39	attainment with the public high schools in the school divisions that such comprehensive community
<b>40</b>	college serves specifying the options for students to complete an associate degree or a one-year Uniform
41	Certificate uniform certificate of General Studies general studies concurrent with a high school diploma.
42	Such agreements shall specify the credit available for dual enrollment courses and Advanced Placement
43	courses with qualifying exam scores of three or higher. Credit received for the successful completion of
44	any dual enrollment course offered pursuant to an agreement for postsecondary degree attainment
45	developed pursuant to this subsection shall satisfy degree requirements at each public institution of
46	higher education.
