| 12                         | § 28.2-706. Restrictions on crab scraping; penalty.  |
| 13                         | It is unlawful for any person to:  |
| 14                         | 1. Use a crab scrape having a mouth longer than four feet and a toothed bar;   |
| 15                         | 2. Haul a scrape, except by hand; or   |
| 16                         | 3. Have more than two scrapes overboard; or  |
| 17                         | 4. Possess hard crabs while having a crab scrape on board.   |
| 18                         | A violation of any provision of this section is a Class 3 misdemeanor.   |
